

Riverlands Golf & Country Club Golf Course Rules

1. All Members and Guests must register in the Golf Shop prior to play.
2. Tee times for Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays may be made for Threesomes and Foursomes only. Singles, Twosomes, and Fivesomes are not permitted on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.
3. Each player must have his or her own set of clubs and a bag to play the course.
4. All players must start at #1 tee unless authorized differently by Golf Professional or Golf Staff.
5. The pace of play is enforced; players must keep pace with the group directly in front and should allow faster groups to play through. Do not break play for any extended period of time between #9 green and #10 tee.
6. Proper golf attire is required at all times on the course and practice facilities. Shirts without collars and cut-off shorts are not permitted. We are soft spikes only.
7. Players will be assigned starting times by the Golf Professional or the Golf Staff. Players must be on the tee for their starting time so as not to forfeit their starting time. Starting times on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays may be obtained by calling or coming in the Golf Shop on Wednesday at 8:00am (For Friday), Thursday at 8:00am (For Saturday), and Friday at 8:00am (For Sunday) and two days in advance for Holidays.
8. Tuesday is Ladies' Day unless a Holiday, and only Ladies can start on #1 tee between 8:30am and 9:30am.
9. Children or not allowed on the golf course unless playing golf. Furthermore, children under 14 years of age may not tee off before 2:00 pm on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays unless accompanied by an adult.
10. Practice on putting greens and range only. Practice is not permitted on the course.
11. Sand all divots (bottles can be refilled at every tee box), repair your ball mark and at least one other and be courteous and completely rake traps. Littering will not be tolerated, please use trashcans and keep the course clean.
12. Scorecards shall be turned in with names, member #'s, tees played, date, and accurate hole scores to be recorded for handicap purposes.
13. Jogging, walking, bicycling, swimming, fishing, hunting or discharging of firearms on the course is not permitted.
14. Golf carts and pull carts must stay off tees and greens and must return to the cart path upon reaching the Gold-Topped Cart Stakes in front of greens. The Golf Course Superintendent and/or the Golf Professional will determine whether the conditions are suitable for electric golf carts to follow the **90 Degree Rule** and get off the cart paths or whether the conditions are such that the **Cart Path Only Rule** will be enforced.
15. **No more than (3) carts per foursome are allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS!** Members and guests are encouraged to share carts whenever possible to save the course from **IRREVERSIBLE** wear and tear.
16. Club-owned rental carts may only be rented for play by a person with and of the age to possess a **valid** driver's license. Rental carts for 9 holes and 18 holes are just that. **A CART RENTAL FEE IS NOT GOOD FOR THE ENTIRE DAY.** The cart renter will be responsible for the fees associated with playing additional holes. The fees will automatically be billed to the member's account if he/she does not notify the golf shop.
17. **Private carts are a privilege associated with membership at Riverlands Golf & Country Club.** The private cart owner shall adhere to all club rules pertaining to cart usage. The adult owners of private carts will be held responsible for any violation committed by children using the private cart.
18. The Golf Professional or Golf Staff shall enforce all Golf Course Rules. Report infractions to the Golf Professional or Golf Staff so that action may be taken. Failure of players to adhere by the rules shall be reported by the Golf Professional or Golf Staff to The Board of Directors. Penalties may result.

Regulations on Conduct of Members and Guests

1. Upon request, members will be required to give their membership number when using the facilities and/or be identified by an accredited member. Furthermore, guests of members will be required to verify their guest privileges under the specific member's account.
2. Members in arrears or under suspension shall not have the privileges of the club; those who have been dropped from the roll for non-payment of dues or other cause shall not be permitted on the property.
3. Willful or careless injury/ damage to club property by a member or guest shall render the person causing it liable for the full extent thereof.
4. Obscene language or conduct will not be tolerated and subject to fine and/or suspension.
5. No subscription papers or notices of any description other than official notices shall be circulated or posted on the club premises without authority of the Board of Directors.
6. All Members and guests must be properly dressed while on the premises, except swimmers going to and from or in the pool. Collared shirts are required on the premises. No muscle shirts, cut-off shorts, or swimming apparel allowed in the clubhouse. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
7. Riverlands has a fully stocked and fully staffed bar and grill, private coolers and outside food or beverage are not allowed. Cooler bags will be distributed from the bar for a \$10.00 deposit. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. No reprimand shall be given to any employee of the club. To receive attention, complaint or suggestion must be made in writing to The Board of Directors.
9. The club does not assume responsibility for any loss or damage to personal property and effects of members or guests.
9. The name of any member violating the above rules shall be submitted to the Board of Directors and subject to reprimand, fine or suspension.
